If on opening the financial bid it is found that there are more than one eligible offerer that can be selected as technical consultant, then KITTS reserves its right to choose one or more technical consultant by giving the participant offerers an option to match the best offer obtained by KITTS under the Expression of Interest.
- 7. The same course will be not be available for more than one offerer, in any case.
- 8. The office premises of all the applicant firms considered for selection on the panel of KITTS for the above purpose will be inspected by a team of technical officers appointed by KITTS. The team of experts will verify the details provided by the applicant firms, space and other relevant documents.

- 9. The EOI from the firms will be scrutinized with reference to the qualification criteria prescribed in the document and inspection reports. The Financial bids of only those applicants will be opened who fulfill the minimum eligibility criteria after verification.
- 10. The technical bid and financial bid should be submitted along with the required documents.
- 11. Though consultants are selected for a period of three years, after the third year KITTS will have the right to extend the contract up to 2 (two) years after assessment of the performance of the selected firms/parties on mutually agreed terms and rate and conditions.
