A. Introduction

Kerala Institute of Tourism and Travel Studies (KITTS) impart quality education and training in the field of Travel and Tourism. B. Job Description

Sealed Tenders in prescribed format are invited from agencies for supplying life saving equipments for the training needs.

The tender documents can be head form the KITTS Head Quarters during the office hours on payment of Rs.200/- .Those are downloading from website should send the tender application fee as demand draft in favour of Director, KITTS along with the bid. The last date for submission of tenders is 24/04/2012 at 02.30pm hours. The bids shall be opened on same day at 03.30 pm in the presence of the bidder's representative who choose to be present at the office of the undersigned during the evaluation process. The Technical bid and price bid should be given in separate envelopes. The Price bid shall be opened only for those bidders who satisfy the eligibility criteria mentioned in the tender document. Those who are meeting the eligibility criteria and are interested to supply the products subject to the terms and conditions may furnish their quotes in the prescribed form enclosed herewith and with copies of other required documents indicated in the tender document.

C. Eligibility criteria

(i) Essential

- a) The Bidder should be a Manufacturer or Manufacturer's Authorized Dealer
- b) If the bid is submitted by an authorized dealer then he/she should have Manufacturer's Authorization letter to quote in this Tender and Manufacturer to give all Technical & Commercial support and Warranty and After Sales Services. The Authorized Dealer should have valid Agreement with the Manufacturer and also should have Authorization from the Manufacturer effective from at least one year prior to the due date of this tender.
- c) Bidder shall submit valid copies of the MMD certificate for life jacket and lifebuoy
- d) The annual average turnover of the bidder should not be less than Rs.25 lakhs in the last three financial years.

e) The bidder must have minimum Five (5) years of experience in the field of manufacturing and supplying lifebuoys and life jackets.

(ii) Desirable

1. Experience with proof of supplying lifesaving equipments to Central/ State government departments/PSUs etc.

D. Terms and conditions

1. The vendors will have to submit an interest free, refundable earnest money deposit (E.M.D) of Rs.2000/- in the form of a Bank Draft / Pay Order of Scheduled Commercial Bank drawn in favour of **Director, Kerala Institute of Tourism and Travel Studies at Thiruvananthapuram**. The DD should be kept along with Technical bid envelop.

2. The Agency shall supply the equipments with the contract to the complete satisfaction of the Institute.

3. In case of default on the part of the agency in carrying out any order, Institute shall be entitled to get the work done by any other persons and all expenses consequent thereon or incidental there to shall be borne by the Institute and will be deducted by the institute from any money due or it may become due to the agency.

4. The decision of the Institute in the matter arising out of this contract shall be final and binding in regard to all matters relating to the contract.

5. All cases/proceedings relating to any dispute or claim arising out of or any case of performance of this contract shall be falling in proper court having jurisdiction in Thiruvananthapuram.

6. The Institute shall have right to issue addendum to tendered documents to clarify, amend, modify supplement or delete any of the condition, clause or items stated therein. Each addendum shall form a part of the original invitation to tender.

2) Rescue Tube

The Rescue tube should be made of Cell foam for durability and should have double red coated for added protection. The strap should run all the way through the tube for added strength and durability.

It must have reinforced edges which stay during the time of rescue. It should have minimum 40 inch size. It should be written GUARD on it

Dimension min required 40inches X 6 inches X 3 1/4 inch.

3) Life jacket

- **Life Jacket manufactured from soft polyethylene foam with high visibility orange color fabric, reflective Stickers chemically resistant to sea, water and Petroleum products.**
- Quick turning time and high free board in water owing to special construction (even if a person falls into water in unconscious state with face downwards the body will automatically turn upwards due to the buoyancy of the jacket).
- Soft polyethylene foam
- Orange colored nylon cover enhances visibility.
- The light of the Life jacket should be of integrated with Lithium battery
